The Certified Information Security Manager (CISM) certification is a unique management focused certification that has been earned by over 9,000 professionals since its introduction in 2003. Unlike other security certifications, CISM is for the individual who manages, designs, oversees and assesses an enterprise's information security program. CISM defines the core competencies and international performance standards that those who have information security management responsibilities must master.



The IT Governance certification is intended to recognize a wide range of professionals for their knowledge and application of IT governance principles and practices. More than 200 CGEIT certificates have been awarded. It is designed for professionals who have management, advisory, or assurance responsibilities as defined by a "job practice" consisting of IT governance related tasks and knowledge. ### CRISC Update

The Certified in Risk and Information Systems Control<sup>TM</sup> (CRISC<sup>TM</sup>, pronounced "see-risk") grandfathering program continues. ISACA has certified the 1,000th CRISC Professional four months into its grandfathering program. The CRISC grandfathering program will remain open through 31 March 2011. After the grandfathering period has closed, candidates will be required to pass the CRISC exam in addition to fulfilling other requirements to attain the designation. The first CRISC exam will be administered in June 2011.

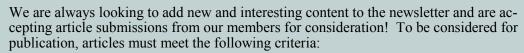
