Presentation Overview:

The process of assessing, analyzing, and managing security risk can be tricky. Often, technical and security staff get entangled with the “paralysis of analysis” which hinders progress. Risk management is about understanding, not eliminating all risks. This presentation provides a systematic approach for effectively conducting a risk analysis and managing the residual risks to an acceptable level.

The presentation will:

- ◆ Identify the difference between risk analysis and risk assessment
- ◆ Define the basic steps used in completing a risk analysis; how to identify threats, evaluate current security controls, determine vulnerabilities, and prioritize risks
- ◆ Demonstrate how to perform and document a risk analysis through “hands-on” exercises
- ◆ Describe how to present a risk analysis report and manage risks through a remediation plan
- ◆ Discuss some best practices and emerging concepts

Speakers: Tom Walsh, CISSP - President, Tom Walsh Consulting, LLC

Tom Walsh is a nationally recognized speaker who launched his own consulting practice in 2003. Tom and his associates conduct risk analyses, compliance evaluation, disaster recovery planning, security training, and remediation activity for clients. Tom is also the co-author of four books on healthcare information security.

January 15, 2013: Deadline for membership renewals.

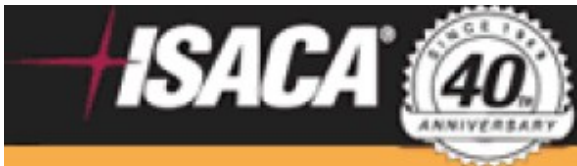

2013 IT Risk/Reward Barometer Results Now Available

The results are in from this year's IT Risk/Reward Barometer survey. More than 4,000 IT professionals from 83 countries participated in the survey and the results contain some interesting findings on industry trends like the Internet of Things, mobile devices (BYOD), and big data. The global results reveal:

- ◆ More than half of the respondents report plans to capitalize on the Internet of Things
- ◆ The vast majority of consumers worry that their information will be stolen, yet they will engage in risk behaviors such as reusing passwords
