Presentation Overview:

Ryan Bachman and Thad Bogner will be demonstrating techniques of how to break into a network. They will be demonstrating pentesting tools and techniques as well as discussing important policy decisions that will greatly reduce a company's attack surface. In addition, they will provide case studies based on common vulnerabilities that they have seen in their security testing as well as easy ways to help prevent many of the tactics hackers use to get into computer networking environments.

Speakers:

Ryan Bachman is a Director in the Advisory Security practice of PwC focusing in assessment, design, and implementation of security architecture and strategy. He was responsible for information security strategy, policy, standards, awareness, assessment and oversight, as well as privacy and data governance. With over 7 years of Big 4 consulting experience specializing in Information Security and Privacy, Ryan also augments his consulting experience with over 5 years of private industry experience serving within an IT and Information Security organization of a Fortune 50 global telecommunications firm and a major broker-dealer/bank. Ryan is a Certified Information Systems Security Professional, Certified Anti-Money Laundering Specialist, and a HITRUST Certified Assessor.

Thad Bogner is a senior associate in the Advisory Security practice of PwC where he leads PwC's national attack and penetration core team. He has performed dozens of attack and penetration assessments using a combination of commercial, open source, and manual pentesting methods. Thad is the founder of multiple DEFCON security groups in Northern California and is a member of a globally recognized team of security professionals which compete in ethical hacking competitions, including DEFCON and DerbyCon. He is also a Certified Information Systems Security Professional (CISSP).

New SOC 2 User Guide Available

ISACA has just published a SOC 2 User Guide in conjunction with AICPA. For those not familiar with it, SOC 2 is a Report on Controls at a Service Organization Relevant to Security, Availability, Processing Integrity, Confidentiality or Privacy. The guide is intended for those evaluating a service organization's SOC 2 report as part of a governance, risk and compliance (GRC) program; vendor assessment; security evaluation; business continuity plan or other control evaluation. It can be very useful when considering a new vendor as part of the request for proposal (RFP) process.
